16/767 Apologies : It was **RESOLVED** to accept apologies from P Hooper and P Warren.

16/769 Comments from the Public – A member of the public spoke in relation to a planning application WND/2021/0144 - Amendment to planning permission DA/2009/0116 (Change of use of land for holding leisure, tourism and charitable events) to enlarge site area to include land to northwest and increase number of show days from 18 to 30 days and extend build and breakdown days from 70 to 90 days per calendar year at Kelmarsh Hall, Main Road, Kelmarsh, Northamptonshire, NN6 9LY.

The Clerk confirmed that the Parish Council had now been formally consulted by WNDC and that the application had been slightly amended to the following :

WND/2021/0144 - Amendment to planning permission DA/2009/0116 (Change of use of land for holding leisure, tourism and charitable events) to enlarge site area to include land to northwest **and eastern side** to increase number of show days from 18 to 30 days and extend build and breakdown days from 70 to 90 days per calendar year at Kelmarsh Hall, Main Road, Kelmarsh, Northamptonshire, NN6 9LY.

16/770 Planning Applications :

WND/2021/0225 Removal of tree within a conservation area

At 6, Pegs Lane, Clipston, Northamptonshire, LE16 9SB – It was **RESOLVED** to offer **NO OBJECTION** to the application.

WND/2021/0225 Amendment to planning permission DA/2009/0116 (Change of use of land for holding leisure, tourism and charitable events) to enlarge site area to include land to northwest side and increase number of show days from 18 to 30 days and extend build and breakdown days from 70 to 90 days per calendar year. – It was **RESOLVED** to make the following comment : 'We request that a condition is placed upon events that music must not be played after 1am in order to minimise the disturbance to residents' . This resolution was made after the rejection of the suggestion to make a planning application to vary the 2009 planning consent owing to the proposal received was from one household only and the costs to the Council incurred by this route.
