222/23	UPDATE FROM UNITARY COUNCILLORS Apologies received from Unitary Councillors Irving-Swift and Harris. Unitary Councillor Parker advised that The Boundary Review has been published. The information can be found on the LGBCE Website https://www.lgbce.org.uk/ For the Clipston area there are no further changes to the proposed rural North East Ward with one Councillor for each of the three Brixworth Wards. It was noted the Boundary review appears consistent with the Clipston Parish Boundary. Councillor Parker was asked if there is a policy in place with West Northants Council to renew the faded road markings and signs,. Not aware of a policy to automatically renew the markings, but matters should be reported to Highways via Fix My Street. Regarding planning, Councillor Parker has spoken to the Planning Department about explanations of Planning Application categories. The 28 Day Prior Application we are advised will go into the Town and Parish Council newsletter along with other explanations of references. It appears that an example of a 28 day application would be an application to the planning authority to ask if permission is required or permitted development.


